On October 5, 2021, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-73 which makes the legally required findings to continue to authorize remote meeting participation for legislative body members per Assembly Bill 361. City Council will continue to make this finding every 30 days. Some or all of the legislative body may participate in meetings via teleconference.
