Community Workshops Jan. 13, Jan. 29, & Feb. 10, 2022	Informational presentations, discussions of communities of interest and demonstration of public mapping tools
Public Hearing 2 Feb. 23, 2022 @ 6:30 p.m.	Discuss and revise draft maps; Commission asked to recommend map(s) to Council
Draft map submittal deadline February 28, 2022 @ 11:59 p.m.	Deadline for community members to submit proposed maps for the March 8 th Hearing
Public Hearing 3 March 8, 2022 @ 6:30 p.m.	Council discuss and revise draft maps and discuss the election sequence
Public Hearing 4 March 29, 2022 @ 6:30 p.m.	Council discuss and select final map. Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption

Redistricting Rules and Goals

1. Federal Laws

Equal Population
Federal Voting Rights Act
No Racial Gerrymandering



2. California Criteria for Cities

- 1. Geographically contiguous
- 2. Undivided neighborhoods and "communities of interest"

(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)

- 3. Easily identifiable boundaries
- 4. Compact

(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

Prohibited: "Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party."

3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles

Minimize voters shifted to different election years

Respect voters' choices / continuity in office

Future population growth

Preserving the core of existing districts


