**CALL TO ORDER**

### **2. 2023 ORANGE COUNTY COMPLETE STREETS PROGRAM CALL FOR PROJECTS – HARBOR BLVD**

Staff Member Chinchilla presented on the Orange County Complete Streets grant application staff was preparing for Harbor Boulevard from Valley View Drive to Bastanchury Road.

Norby moved, seconded by Leslie, to concur with the City Traffic Engineer's opinion that the "Gem Streets District" is not a good candidate for on-street angled parking and to receive and file the report.

Norby asked for information about the next Parking Board Hearing.

Carvalho asked for an update about the permanent improvements at Costco's north driveway on Harbor Boulevard.

Carvalho asked for information about the traffic striping on Associated Road, north of Yorba Linda

Boulevard, and the traffic signal at Associated Road and Bastanchury Road.

Norby asked for information about the opening of Sherbeck Field on the campus of Fullerton College.
