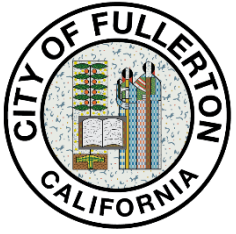
# Background

- On November 5, 2019, City Council approved the Athletic Field Use and Allocation Policy to guide field use and allocation. The policy supports partnerships with Fullerton youth sports and the public to provide safe, well-maintained fields for recreational activities.
- With the City no longer managing field allocations at Ralph B. Clark Park and Fullerton School District handling its fields, this outlines the current process for allocating fields to our seven Youth Sports Partner Leagues, rentals, and future challenges.



# Field Priority

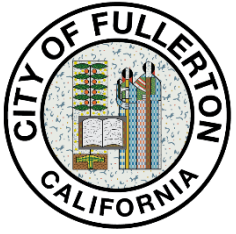
- Per the Athletic Field Use and Allocation Policy priority group classifications are as follows:
  - Partner Group – 1<sup>st</sup> Priority: Fullerton-based, recreational non-profits (80% Fullerton residents) with state/national affiliations. Must be a 501(c)(3), based in Fullerton, with volunteer-only coaches and board members, and follow a conflict-of-interest policy.
  - Fullerton Competitive Group – 2<sup>nd</sup> Priority: Fullerton-based 501(c)(3) youth sports nonprofits with 55%+ Fullerton residents and state/national affiliation. Must submit participant and team details by the deadline, with partial rosters if teams aren't finalized.
  - Rental Group – 3<sup>rd</sup> Priority: Rental groups do not meet the standards listed above for Partner and Fullerton Competitive groups. These groups get third priority for field allocation. Rental groups are limited in the number of reservations they can make.



# Partner Leagues

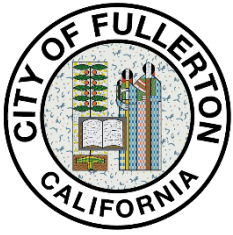
- Parks and Recreation Partner Leagues: Fullerton youth sports leagues with 80% Fullerton residents. They must be Fullerton-based 501(c)(3) nonprofits, affiliated with a state or national sports body, with volunteer-only coaches and board members, following a conflict-of-interest policy.





# Field Allocation – Step 1

- City staff send allocation packets to all partner leagues a month in advance before the deadline.
  - Applications include
    - Field Request packets
    - Special Event and Tournament requests
    - City's Athletic Field Use Rules and Regulation form
    - Hold Harmless Agreement forms
- Partner leagues must submit the following:
  - Certificate of insurance
  - Rosters
  - Non-profit letter
  - Practice and Game schedules

### ATHLETIC FIELD USE RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Groups consisting of 25 or more individuals wishing to utilize a field must acquire a permit with the City of Fullerton - FMC 3.84.000 Groups of 25 or more individuals require a field permit to utilize Lanes Field - 2024 Adopted City Policy.)

It is the responsibility of the person(s) in charge identified on the permit to enforce the rules and regulations regarding the conduct of the group while on permitted facilities. These rules include but are not limited to:

- Use begins and ends at the times stated on the permit including set-up and clean up. Groups are not allowed on facilities prior to the start time on the permit and are required to leave the fields clean and vacated by the ending time indicated on the permit. Permitted times include field preparation and player "warm-up". Additional fees will be charged for unauthorised or extended field use beyond approved times listed on the permit.
- Field permits will not be issued for use on Federal Holidays.
- Field use permit must be available during use at each permitted site and presented to any City representative upon request.
- No subsiding of fields is allowed under any circumstances. Subsiding of fields may result in revocation of any and all permits.
- City fields or facilities may not be modified without permission from the City. Fields may not be resced without permission from the City.

Traveling is allowed in designated areas only. User groups must inform their participants and spectators to park in facility parking lots and public parking areas. It is the user's responsibility to alleviate traffic and parking issues.

- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in City parks, fields, or adjacent areas. (F.M.C. 9122 / C.V.C. 25620)
- Organizations/groups utilizing vendors during their games and tournaments to sell food or other items must submit vendor's insurance certificate, endorsement letter, and City of Fullerton Business License number (obtain at the Finance Department) to the Recreation Department at a minimum of two (2) weeks prior to their event.
- Amplified sound is not allowed on any field without City approval and notation on permit.
- Banners or yard signs may not be posted without City approval and notation on permit.
- Balls and any other equipment thrown, batted, kicked, or otherwise propelled that land on private property must not be retrieved without the property owner's permission.
- At the conclusion of games or practice each user group is responsible for picking up trash and/or debris and depositing it into the proper trash bins. The field and any areas adjoining affected by a group's use must be picked up and cleared of all trash and/or debris.
- Please vacate park and parking areas immediately after games and practices safely and quietly, especially after late games. Please practice being good neighbors in our residential neighborhoods.

City staff may reject any person not complying with the above rules or ordinance regarding PARKS in F.M.C. Chapter 912 S. Chapter 3.84.

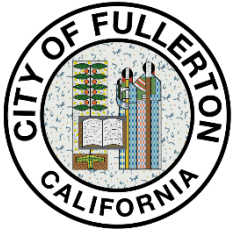

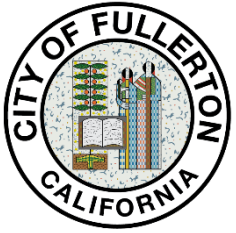

## Field Allocation – Step 2

- City staff receive partner leagues field request, review and identify the following:
  - The field “needs” for all organizations
  - Any conflicting request with other organizations
  - The impact on other organizations
  - History of previous request
- After staff review all applications. Staff inform the Partner Leagues of all conflicts.
- The Athletic Policy states that users must find a resolution before the user group meeting.



# Field Allocation – Allocation Meeting

- City staff, School District staff, and partner groups meet Semi- annually before each season begins.
- During the meeting:
  - Staff shares field closures, rules and regulations
  - Staff receive feedback from the organization on any challenges they face throughout the season
  - Landscape shares any upcoming field projects
  - Roundtable
- End of Meeting:
  - Staff review all field conflicts with the group
  - If conflicts are not resolved, the policy is reference and the group with most residents obtains field permit.
    - Currently the policy does not have a tie-breaker.
- Once all conflicts have been resolved permits are issued to Partner Leagues



## Field Allocation – Final Step

- Once all fields have been allocated to Partner Leagues staff reallocate the additional fields to all group users.
  - Groups obtain remaining fields
  - Formal meetings are not held for remaining group categories.

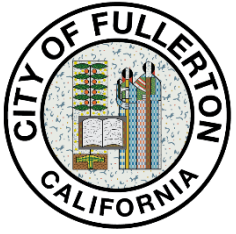


# City Fields Inventory

### SUMMARY

The City of Fullerton is actively working on redesigning Independence Park. The Parks and Recreation Commission is being presented with the results for the community input process. Staff is seeking direction from the Commission on the final list of elements to include in the Independence Park design plan.

### RECOMMENDATION

1. Review and recommend that staff incorporate the following elements into the Independence Park master plan design: preserving the racquetball courts, and skate park; incorporate new restrooms, an inclusive play structure, a central picnic shelter, a splash pad/water feature, and pickleball courts; and exclude a dog park.
2. Provide alternate direction to staff.

### FISCAL IMPACT

Independence Park has \$2,000,000 allocated in the current fiscal year from the Park Dwelling fund. Approximately \$3.5M in federal and state funds have been earmarked for this project. The final project budget will be determined once the project design has been finalized.

### BACKGROUND

Independence Park is a 10-acre community park that has been one of the most popular parks in Fullerton for many years. The park's current condition requires additional resources to restore and make it a destination for our community. The playground has

been removed due to safety concerns, the skate park has been vandalized multiple times, and the gymnasium has been closed since COVID-19. One of the park's highlights continues to be the handball courts, which have remained open throughout the years and are highly utilized. Upon completion of the Union Pacific Trail, Independence Park will serve as a gateway to the trail.

## DISCUSSION

Staff invited the community to a meeting on September 25th, 2024, at the Fullerton Community Center to discuss the design and amenities proposed for Independence Park and participate in a survey. The survey was live for the entire month of October, and approximately 350 responses were submitted.

The survey engaged a broad cross-section of Fullerton residents, collecting data on park visitation habits, preferences for new amenities, and feedback on current facilities.

### Summary of Survey Results:

1. Handball Courts (59 mentions): Highly valued for their cultural and recreational significance. Requests include maintaining indoor and outdoor courts, improving lighting, and hosting tournaments.
2. Skate Park (25 mentions): Recognized as essential for youth activities, with suggestions to expand and improve safety and maintenance.
3. Playground (34 mentions): Desire for an inclusive, shaded playground with modern equipment.
4. Trees (12 mentions): Calls for more trees to enhance natural shade and aesthetic value.
5. Racquetball Courts (18 mentions): Advocacy for reopening and renovating indoor courts for year-round recreational use.
6. Restrooms (22 mentions): Strong demand for clean and accessible restrooms to meet park-goers' needs.
7. Lighting (29 mentions): Improved lighting across the park for safety, particularly at night.
8. Splash Pad/Water Feature (14 mentions): Desired as a family-friendly addition, especially during summer.
9. Pickleball Courts (15 mentions): A popular request to diversify recreational activities.
10. Central Picnic Shelter: Suggested for family gatherings and community events.
11. Water Fountains (8 mentions): Need for functional water fountains and refill stations.
12. Dog Park (7 mentions): Mixed opinions; some oppose due to existing facilities nearby, while others support a smaller designated area.
13. Homelessness (15 mentions): Concerns about safety and usability due to unhoused individuals in the park.
14. Trash (9 mentions): Requests for better trash management to maintain cleanliness.

The survey responses reveal significant community engagement and interest in the redevelopment of Independence Park. Key themes include the preservation of existing recreational amenities, the addition of new facilities to enhance usability and inclusivity, and the improvement of safety and maintenance measures.

Respondents emphasized the cultural and recreational importance of the handball courts, skate park, and racquetball courts, advocating for their preservation and enhancement. There is also strong support for incorporating family-friendly amenities, such as an inclusive play structure, central picnic shelters, and a splash pad or water feature. These additions align with the community's desire for spaces that support family activities and cater to children of all abilities.

Additionally, there is a clear need for improved infrastructure, particularly the addition of restrooms, functional water fountains, and enhanced lighting throughout the park. Safety and cleanliness emerged as recurring concerns, with multiple comments highlighting issues related to unhoused individuals and insufficient maintenance of existing facilities. While some respondents expressed interest in a dog park, the feedback was mixed, with others arguing against its inclusion due to the proximity of existing facilities and concerns about space allocation.

### **Recommendations**

Based on the survey results and staff's analysis, the following recommendations are proposed for the Independence Park redevelopment plan:

**Preservation of Key Amenities:** Maintain and enhance existing recreational facilities, including the handball courts, skate park, and racquetball courts. Improvements should focus on updating infrastructure, such as lighting and seating, and providing opportunities for community-driven activities like tournaments.

**Incorporation of New Features:** Include an inclusive play structure, a central picnic shelter, and a splash pad or water feature to create a family-friendly environment. These features align with community priorities and address the need for inclusive and interactive amenities.

**Infrastructure Improvements:** Construct new restrooms to enhance accessibility and usability for all visitors. Additional infrastructure improvements should include shaded areas, water fountains, and expanded lighting to ensure comfort and safety throughout the park.

**Exclusion of a Dog Park:** Exclude plans for a dog park based on mixed community feedback, instead focusing resources on features with broader support.

**Addressing Safety and Cleanliness:** Enhance park security through increased lighting, surveillance, and routine patrols to mitigate safety concerns. Implement better maintenance practices to address trash management and maintain cleanliness across all park facilities. Partnering with social services may also help address challenges

associated with unhoused individuals in the park.

The community feedback highlights a strong desire to create a balanced park design that preserves cherished recreational features while incorporating new, inclusive amenities. By addressing infrastructure needs and safety concerns, Independence Park can evolve into a space that serves the diverse needs of the Fullerton community, fostering a safe, inclusive, and vibrant environment for recreation and connection.
