### **SUMMARY**

Cooperative Agreement for traffic signals and safety lighting maintenance between City of Fullerton and City of Anaheim.

### **PROPOSED MOTION**

Approve Cooperative Agreement for Maintenance of Traffic Signals and Safety Lighting between the City of Fullerton and the City of at five shared intersections and authorize Director of Public Works to take actions necessary to implement and administer the Cooperative Agreement.

## FISCAL IMPACT

Entering this Cooperative Agreement with City of Anaheim generates no additional fiscal impact to the City of Fullerton. The City would receive monthly payments from the City of Anaheim for their share (as shown in the following table) of traffic signal and safety lighting maintenance costs. The Traffic Signals Program budget in the General Fund (Fund 10) includes the City cost share.

## BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The City of Fullerton has traffic signals and safety lighting maintenance agreements with the City of Anaheim. The proposed agreement would share traffic signals and safety lighting maintenance costs. The following table lists the maintenance agreements between Fullerton and Anaheim for four shared intersections:

Intersection	City of Fullerton	City of Anaheim
Lemon Street and Orangefair Avenue	50%	50%
Lemon Street and Orangethorpe Avenue	50%	50%
Orangethorpe Avenue and Raymond Avenue	50%	50%
Orangethorpe Avenue and State College Boulevard	75%	25%

Fullerton will install a new traffic signal at Lemon Street and Liberty Avenue, located between the City of Fullerton and the City of Anaheim, as part of a private development. Lemon Street is in Fullerton jurisdiction and Liberty Avenue, on the east side, is in Anaheim jurisdiction. The City of Fullerton would maintain and operate this new traffic signal. The developer pays the full cost to install the traffic signal at Lemon Street and Liberty Avenue. Anaheim would need to pay its fair share of maintenance costs for this shared jurisdiction.

Fullerton would pay 75% and Anaheim 25% of the new shared intersection at Lemon Street and Liberty Avenue maintenance cost.

Proposed Intersection	City of Fullerton	City of Anaheim
Lemon Street and Liberty Avenue	75%	25%

This revised Cooperative Agreement would add the new shared traffic signal to the existing list of shared intersections and supersede the previous agreements. The existing shared cost percentages would remain the same.
