

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, CONCERNING THE CIRCULATION ELEMENT AND MITIGATION FEE PROGRAM FOR THE MEASURE M (M2) PROGRAM STATUS AND UPDATE

WHEREAS, the City of Fullerton desires to maintain and improve the streets within its jurisdiction, including arterials contained in the Master Plan of Arterial Highways (MPAH).

WHEREAS, the City of Fullerton endorsed a definition of and process for determining the City Traffic Circulation Plan consistency with the MPAH.

WHEREAS, the City adopted a General Plan Circulation Element which does not preclude MPAH implementation within its jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a resolution biennially informing the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) that the City Circulation Element conforms with the MPAH and whether the City adopted any changes to any arterial highways of said Circulation Element during Fiscal Years (FY) 2023-24 and FY 2024-25.

WHEREAS, the City must send biennially to the OCTA all recommended changes to the City Circulation Element and the MPAH to re-qualify for Comprehensive Transportation Funding Programs participation.

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a resolution biennially certifying the City has an existing Mitigation Fee Program that assesses new development traffic impacts and requires new development to pay a fair share of necessary transportation improvements attributable to the new development.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Fullerton informs OCTA that:
 - a. The arterial highway portion of the Circulation Element of the City conforms with the MPAH.
 - b. The City attests it has not made any unilateral through lane reductions any MPAH arterials during FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25.
 - c. The City affirms it will bring forward requests to amend the MPAH, when necessary, to ensure the MPAH and General Plan Circulation Element remain consistent.
 - d. The City reaffirms the existing Mitigation Fee Program remain in effect.
