Naming Korean War Memorial Park!

Naming the North portion of the Duck Pond where the Korean War Memorial Monument is, as the Korean War Memorial Park!

This naming will make it easier to locate and visit the Korean War Memorial Monument where 36, 591 brave US soldiers who gave their all during the Korean War and further put the City of Fullerton on the map, recognizing sacrifices of our USA soldiers who saved the Korean Peninsula from becoming the Communist bloc.

The alliance between the USA and Republic of Korea is iron clad strong, forged in blood, due to precious sacrifices of these heroes.

From the State of California, there are 2,612 names and from Orange County there are 58 names of heroes inscribed at this Korean War Memorial Monument.

This naming will further put and recognize the City of Fullerton, as the host city and home of the first and only Korean War Memoria in the West, as the only one is in the Lincoln Park, Washington DC.

Fullerton's Korean War Memorial Monument was dedicated on the Veterans Day, November 11, 2021, and the Korean Wall of Remembrance in Washington DC was installed on July 27th, 2022.
