**MEETINGS:** The Fullerton City Council / Successor Agency meets on the first and third Tuesday of the month, convening for First Session at 4:00 p.m. and Second Session at 5:30 p.m. Council Members may participate in meetings via teleconference in accordance with California Brown Act (Government Code Section 54950 et seq) provisions.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: The public can access meetings streamed live online at https://fullerton.legistar.com, on Spectrum Cable Channel 3 and AT&T U-Verse Channel 99.

The Council Chamber has seating available on a first-come, first-served basis for those attending the meeting in person. All persons visiting City facilities shall observe health, safety and decorum protocols.

**ADDRESSING CITY COUNCIL:** To address City Council remotely, please follow the *Instructions for Public Comment Using Zoom.* To address City Council in Chambers, please register for each agenda item in the City Manager's Office. You do not need to provide your name to register. Staff will call you to the microphone when it is your turn to speak. You may state your name and city of residence for the record at the beginning of your remarks. All speakers shall observe civility, decorum and good behavior. Any item submitted to City Council during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.

The public may comment on Closed Session items at the beginning of the Closed Session meeting. The public may comment on matters not appearing on the agenda and Consent Calendar items during Public Comments at the Regular Session meeting. The public may request City Council remove consent items for further discussion during Public Comments. City Council will pull Consent Calendar items at its discretion. Those wishing to speak on a regular business or a public hearing item on this agenda may do so when the Mayor calls that specific item for consideration.

Each speaker addressing non-agenda and consent calendar items shall have three minutes to make their remarks. City Council will allow no more than a total of 30 minutes at the beginning of the Regular Session for non-agenda comments. Those speaking on regular business and public hearing items shall have no more than three minutes per item to address City Council. No person shall speak more than one time to the same item. The Mayor may request that a spokesperson represent a group wishing to address City Council. The Mayor or majority of the Council may grant an extension of time for a speaker. No speaker may yield their time to another speaker.

Please contact the City Clerk's Office no later than 48 hours before the meeting to request interpreter assistance.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS USING ZOOM

The public may remotely participate in the meeting to make public comment via computer, smart device or telephone.

Please log on or call in as early as possible to address any technical issues that may occur and ensure you do not miss the time to speak on the desired item.

**Follow these steps to log into Zoom from your computer or smart device** (Your device must have audio capability to participate):

**1.** Use the "raise hand" function to join the queue to speak on the current agenda item when the Mayor calls the item for discussion.

Computer / Smart Device Users: You can find the raise hand option under your participant name.

Telephone Users: Press star-nine (\*9) on your phone to raise your hand. Press star-six (\*6) to unmute when it is your turn to address City Council.

Lower your hand if you choose not to speak or after you have made your comments by unchecking the raise hand option online.

- 2. Staff will call your name or the last four digits of your phone number when it is your time to speak.
- **3.** You may state your name and city of residence at the beginning of your remarks for the minutes.
- **4.** Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.
- **5.** You may log off or hang up after making your comments.
