MEETINGS: The Senior Advisory Committee meets quarterly on the second Tuesday of February, May, August, and November at 11:00 AM in the Fullerton City Council Chamber.

ADDRESSING THE LEGISLATIVE BODY: To address the legislative body in Chambers, please submit a speaker slip to the Secretary. You do not need to provide your name to register. Staff will call you to the microphone when it is your turn to speak. You may state your name and city of residence for the record at the beginning of your remarks. Please follow the *Instructions for Remote Public Comment* to address the legislative body remotely.

The public may comment on matters not appearing on the agenda and Consent Calendar items during Public Comments. The public may request the legislative body remove consent items for further discussion during Public Comments. The legislative body will pull Consent Calendar items at its discretion. Those wishing to speak on all other business items may do so when the Chair calls the item for consideration. All speakers shall observe civility, decorum and good behavior. Any item submitted to the legislative body during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.

Each speaker addressing non-agenda and consent calendar items shall have three minutes to make their remarks. Those speaking on all other business items shall have no more than three minutes per item to address the legislative body. No person shall speak more than one time to the same item. The Chair may request that a spokesperson represent a group wishing to address legislative body. The Chair or majority of the legislative body may grant an extension of time for a speaker. No speaker may yield their time to another speaker.

CORRESPONDENCE: The public can send correspondence to the legislative body regarding agenda items by emailing cityclerksoffice@cityoffullerton.com with the subject line "SENIOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING CORRESPONDENCE - ITEM #" (insert the item number relevant to your comment) or "SENIOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING CORRESPONDENCE NON-AGENDA ITEM". Staff will forward correspondence received to legislative body members. All correspondence received becomes part of the official record of the meeting and posted online with the supplemental materials for that meeting. AGENDA ITEMS: This agenda contains a summary of each item the legislative body will consider. Staff posts the agenda packet online no later than 72 hours prior to the meeting at <https://fullerton.legistar.com>. The Parks and Recreation Department has copies of the packet available for public review.

The public may inspect any writings or documents relating to an open session agenda item distributed less than 72 hours prior to a regular meeting at the Parks and Recreation Department located at 303 West Commonwealth Avenue, Fullerton, California in accordance with CA Government Code Section 54957.5. The City will post such writings and documents received in sufficient time on the City's website at www.cityoffullerton.com.

State regulations prohibit legislative bodies from acting on non-agenda items except as provided by law.

REMINDER: Please silence all electronic devices while the meeting is in session.

REBROADCAST: The City rebroadcasts meetings on local government access channels. The public can find cable channel rebroadcast times as well as view the meeting video on-demand at www.cityoffullerton.com. Please allow up to one week after the meeting for video posting.

ACCESSIBILITY: Staff will make the agenda and backup materials available in appropriate alternative formats upon request to persons with a disability, as required by Section 202 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. Sec. 12132) and the federal rules and regulations adopted in implementation thereof. INSTRUCTIONS FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS USING ZOOM

The public may remotely participate in the meeting to make oral public comments via computer, smart device or telephone.

Please log on or call in as early as possible to address any technical issues that may occur and ensure you do not miss the time to speak on the desired item.

Follow these steps to log into Zoom from your computer or smart device (Your device must have audio capability to participate.):

Go To: www.zoom.us/join
Enter Meeting ID: 160 603 5788

Follow these steps to call into Zoom from your telephone:

Dial 1-669-254-5252 and press pound (#)
Enter Meeting ID: 160 603 5788 (and press pound (#))

Optional: You may enter your name when prompted, but this is not required to participate. Staff will remove anyone entering names that violate community standards.

1. Use the “raise hand” function to join the queue to speak on the current agenda item when the Chair calls the item for discussion.

Computer / Smart Device Users: You can find the raise hand option under your participant name.

Telephone Users: Press star-nine (*9) on your phone to raise your hand. Press star-six (*6) to unmute when it is your turn to address the legislative body.

Lower your hand if you chose not to speak or after you have made your comments by unchecking the raise hand option online.

2. Staff will call your name or the last four digits of your phone number when it is your time to speak.
3. You may state your name and city of residence at the beginning of your remarks for the minutes.
4. Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.
5. You may log off or hang up after making your comments.
