CITY OF FULLERTON AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO THE MAINTENANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE SAYLER GROUP, CORP.

THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE ("Amendment") to the Maintenance Services Agreement is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF FULLERTON ("City"), and THE SAYLER GROUP, CORP., ("Contractor").

RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS, the City and Contractor entered into the Agreement on July 13, 2023 to perform maintenance on Caltrans right-of-way in a Not to Exceed contract amount of \$134,784.
- B. WHEREAS, the City has received funding for this agreement through the Clean California Maintenance Agreement.
- C. WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor desire to amend the contract amount to utilize the unexpended funds from the State, increasing the Not to Exceed amount to \$210,500.
- D. WHEREAS, the City and Contractor desire to provide the City with an additional oneyear extension period.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2.1 of the Agreement, "Compensation", is amended to supersede the fee amounts referenced in Exhibit A of the Agreement, bringing the Not to Exceed amount to \$210,500.
 - 2. Section 4.1 of the Agreement, "Term", is amended to extend the expiration date from June 30, 2024, to June 30, 2025.
- 3. Except as set forth in this Amendment, all terms and provisions of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement, as amended.
- 5. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. All counterparts together with the Agreement and Amendment One shall constitute one agreement.
