

ORDINANCE NO. XXXX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING EXISTING CITY OF FULLERTON GENERAL ORDINANCES WITH SUBJECTS EMBRACED IN THE FULLERTON MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, ordinance adoptions over the past decades resulted in an inadequately arranged and classified Fullerton Municipal Code, insufficient in form to completely preserve public peace, health, safety and general welfare for the municipality and properly conduct City affairs.

WHEREAS, California law empowers and authorizes the City to reorganize, compile, renumber, amend, repeal, restate and codify existing ordinances and new ordinances not yet adopted or published and incorporate such ordinances into one ordinance in book form.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. City Council adopts the City of Fullerton ordinances as revised, amended, restated, codified and compiled and shall constitute the Fullerton Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. City of Fullerton Municipal Code shall consist of the titles in the attached Table of Contents.

SECTION 3. City Council intends amendments to prior ordinances, whether by express amendment, repeal and reenactment, new titling or renumbering, construed as a restatement and continuation of the previous provisions and not a new enactment, if the amendment remains substantially the same as any Code provisions previously adopted and relating to the same subject matter.

SECTION 5. This ordinance includes and reordains, in whole or in part, all prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects treated in the Fullerton Municipal Code adopted by this ordinance. Repealing any ordinance as part of the new Fullerton Municipal Code adoption process shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred or any right established prior to this ordinance effective date, nor shall repeal affect any other City ordinance provisions nor shall repeal affect any other temporary or special nature or pertaining to subject not in or covered by the Municipal Code.

SECTION 6. City Council deems the Fullerton Municipal Code published on the day of City Council adoption and approval. City Council authorizes and orders the City Clerk to file a copy in the Office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 7. Each provision of this ordinance is severable and the invalidity of any section or part shall not affect the validity of other ordinance provisions.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days from and after adoption.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner prescribed by law.
