- Council Members have five minutes each for remarks during City Council / Successor Agency Communications and Reports unless modified by the Mayor or a City Council majority.
- Communications shall relate to matters within City subject matter jurisdiction, may include information related to Council Member service and shall report attendance at events on behalf of the City including attendance at events paid at City expense as required by AB 1234 (2005).
- Council Members shall not engage in negative commentary regarding fellow Council Members, staff or members of the public during Council Communications.
