A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON,
CALIFORNIA, CONCERNING THE MEASURE M2 PROGRAM
PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PLAN STATUS AND UPDATE

WHEREAS, the City of Fullerton must meet eligibility requirements and submit eligibility verification packages to the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) to remain eligible to receive Measure M2 funds.

WHEREAS, the City of Fullerton must adopt an updated Pavement Management Plan (PMP), using the required format, regarding status of road pavement conditions and PMP implementation on a biennial basis.

WHEREAS, the City of Fullerton must provide a plan that manages paved road preservation, rehabilitation and maintenance by analyzing pavement life cycles, assessing overall system performance costs and determining alternative strategies and costs necessary to improve paved roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The PMP conforms with the PMP Submittal Template provided in the Countywide Pavement Management Plan Guidelines.
2. The City adopts a PMP and provided an updated PMP report using the required format to OCTA.
3. City Council authorizes the Public Works Director, City Engineer or designee to sign the PMP certification form.
