PUBLIC COMMENTS: The public may address the legislative body in person or provide public comments remotely by following the *Instructions for Public Comments Using Zoom*.

CORRESPONDENCE: The public can send correspondence to the Infrastructure and Natural Resources Advisory Committee in advance of the meeting by emailing INRAC@cityoffullerton.com or by clicking on the eComment link accompanying the agenda posted online at <https://fullerton.legistar.com>. Staff will forward correspondence received to the Infrastructure and Natural Resources Advisory Committee. Correspondence is not read during the public comment portion of the meeting. However, all correspondence becomes part of the official record of the meeting and is posted online with the supplemental materials for that meeting.

ACCESSIBILITY: If requested, the agenda and backup materials will be made available in appropriate alternative formats to persons with a disability, as required by Section 202 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. Follow these steps to log into Zoom from your computer or smart device (Your device must have audio capability to participate.):

Optional: You may enter your name when prompted, but this is not required to participate. Staff will remove anyone entering names that violate community standards.

- 1. Use the “raise hand” function to join the queue to speak on the current agenda item** when the Chair calls the item for discussion.

Computer / Smart Device Users: You can find the raise hand option under your participant name.

Telephone Users: Press star-nine (*9) on your phone to raise your hand. Press star-six (*6) to unmute when it is your turn to address City Council.

Lower your hand if you chose not to speak or after you have made your comments by unchecking the raise hand option online.

2. Staff will call your name or the last four digits of your phone number when it is your time to speak.
3. You may state your name and city of residence at the beginning of your remarks for the minutes.
4. Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.
5. You may log off or hang up after making your comments.

Prior to public comments, the public may request the removal of consent items for further discussion. Those wishing to speak on a regular business or a public hearing item on this agenda may do so when the Chair calls that specific item for consideration.

Each speaker addressing the Committee may have three minutes to make their remarks. No person shall speak more than one time about the same item. The Chair may request that a spokesperson represent a group wishing to address the Committee. The Chair or majority of the Infrastructure and Natural Resources Advisory Committee may grant an extension of time for a speaker. No speaker may yield their time to another speaker.

PERSONS ADDRESSING THE COMMITTEE: State your name and city of residence for the record at the beginning of your remarks. All speakers shall observe civility, decorum, and good behavior. Any item submitted to the Committee during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.
