#### **Charter Commission**

Election to create commission and select 15 candidates

 Election to adopt proposed charter must occur within two years of commission election

Meeting comply with Brown Act



### **Proposed Commission Timeline**

By July 2026: Call election for November 2026

July / August 2026: Candidate nominations

November 2026: General Municipal Election

December 2026: Election certified



### **Proposed Commission Timeline**

January 2027: Commission begins meeting

By July 2028: Call election for November 2028

November 2028: General Municipal Election

December 2028: Election certified



City Council may draft charter

Can solicit input from ad hoc committee or advisory group

 Council must hold two public hearings before placing on ballot



### **Proposed City Council Timeline**

 Through April 1, 2026: City Council drafts charter (could include ad hoc or advisory group assistance)

April 14, 2026 21-day notice
 (to newspaper by April 1)

May 5, 2026
 First public hearing

May 5 – June 4, 2026 30-day gap between hearings



## **Proposed City Council Timeline**

June 16, 2026: Second public hearing

June 16-July 7, 2026: 21-day waiting period

July 21, 2026: Call November 2026 election

November 2026: General Municipal Election

December 2026: Election certified



General Municipal Election: \$8500 / measure

Special Election Combined with Primary\*: \$200,000 - \$400,000

Stand Alone Special Election: \$250,000 - \$500,000

<sup>\*</sup>June Gubernatorial Primary / March Presidential Primary
