

- Reclassify to a Primary Arterial street (four-lane)
- Request is Categorically Exempt from CEQA per Section 15301(c) and 15304(h)



Project Location and Cross Sections








Project Summary

- Removal of one traffic lane in each direction
- Conversion of Class II bike lanes to Class IV bike lanes
- Construction of continuous sidewalk on both sides
- ADA improvement
- New traffic signal at Harbor/Brea Dam Park
- New central median with drought tolerant landscaping





Background

June 19, 2023: Project presented to INRAC.

September 19, 2023: Public survey posted to obtain feedback on the proposed project.

September 20, 2023: Project presented to ATC. All were in favor of the project and submission of the grant application.

October 2, 2023: Project presented to TCC. All were in favor of the project and submission of the grant application.

October 3, 2023: Project presented to City Council on October 2023: Council authorized staff to submit the grant application.

October 5, 2023: Staff submitted project application to OCTA.

February 12, 2024: OCTA Board approved application.

June 6, 2024: SCAG Board approved project award.

July 2024: City made a social media post on project award and description.

August 29, 2024: OCTA Regional Transportation Planning Committee approved Master Plan of Arterial Highways (MPAH).

September 9, 2024: OCTA Board approved MPAH amendment.

December 16, 2024: Caltrans programed the project into the Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP).

February 6, 2025: Staff submitted RFA-PE documents to Caltrans to review/approve (allocation funding for design).

April 1, 2025: Council accepted grant funding and approved budget appropriations for the project.

October 8, 2025: Planning Commission recommended approval of the street reclassification.
