A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING ZONE IN FRONT OF 1855 WEST AVENUE

WHEREAS, the property owner submitted an application requesting Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) parking adjacent to their property.

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the request, verified for compliance and confirmed the necessity of ADA parking.


WHEREAS the Transportation and Circulation Commission approved the request on February 3, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- City Council approves limiting parking on the north side of West Avenue, in front of 1855 West Avenue (as shown in Exhibit A) to parking for disabled persons vehicles from hereon after.
- 2. City Council directs the Public Works Director to install signs and blue-painted curb giving notice of the restriction at said location.
- 3. The property owner(s) shall notify the City to remove the restriction when no longer in use by residents at the address.
