RECITALS

WHEREAS, Fullerton Municipal Code Chapter 15.72 establishes the process by which amendments to Title 15 are initiated and Section 15.72.020 provides this authority to the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution of Intention will direct staff to draft code language that specifically addresses section of Title 15 of the Fullerton Municipal Code pertaining to accessory dwelling units, historic property designations and sober living / group home facilities to improve clarity, remove inconsistencies and to be consistent with state laws; and


