A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, CERTIFYING THAT THE CITY OF FULLERTON HAS THE RESOURCES TO FUND THE PROJECTS IN THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2022-23 – 2027-28 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND AFFIRMING COMMITMENT TO IMPLEMENT ALL PROJECTS IN THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The City of Fullerton (CITY) is located within the metropolitan planning boundaries of the Southern California Association of Governments.

WHEREAS, The City of Fullerton City Council has authorized project submittals to the Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP).

WHEREAS, CITY is the lead agency for projects (Raymond Grade Separation Project and State College Grade Separation Project) and will comply with applicable local, state and federal provisions including but not limited to the Federal Transportation Improvement Program, California Environmental Quality Act, National Environmental Policy Act, Americans with Disabilities Act and Buy America.

WHEREAS, CITY agrees to construct Transportation Control Measures projects as noted in the amendments in a timely manner or to assist with finding a substitute project.

WHEREAS, CITY preserves the right to submit eligible future projects and certify project funding to the 2023 FTIP.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Fullerton does hereby affirm the City's commitment to the projects submitted in the 2023 Federal Transportation Improvement Program.
