

**CITY OF FULLERTON
AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO TO THE MAINTENANCE SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH SWEEPING CORPORATION OF AMERICA (SCA)**

THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO (“Amendment”) to the Maintenance Services Agreement is made and entered into this _____ day of May 2026 by and between the CITY OF FULLERTON (“City”), and SWEEPING CORPORATION OF AMERICA (“Contractor”).

RECITALS

A. WHEREAS, the City and Contractor entered into the Agreement on June 18, 2019 to perform street cleaning services in the City of Fullerton.

B. WHEREAS, the City has and/or intends to issue a Request for Proposals for a new agreement which requires coordination and preparation, time to solicit proposals, review and award a new contract; therefore, the City desires to extend the term of this Agreement to provide the City the time required.

C. WHEREAS, the City is transitioning to the biweekly, alternating street sweeping schedule approved by the City Council on August 6, 2024, and requires continued services during this transition to ensure uninterrupted street sweeping operations.

D. WHEREAS, the City and Contractor desire to provide the City with an extended street cleaning services of up to one (1) fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The term of the Agreement is extended to June 30, 2027.
2. Effective April 1, 2026, Contractor shall be compensated in accordance with the fee amounts set forth in Exhibit A (“Sweeping Corporation of America Memorandum”) in consideration of the term extension and Contractor’s return to the use of three full time drivers for the provision of the Services. These rates shall remain in effect for the duration of the extended term unless amended in writing by both parties.
3. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement, as amended.
4. Except as set forth in this Amendment, all terms and provisions of the Agreement and all amendments shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. All counterparts together with the Agreement, Amendment One, and Amendment Two shall constitute one agreement.

Thank you to you and the City of Fullerton for the continued partnership over the years. We truly appreciate the opportunity to work collaboratively with your team.

This letter provides a breakdown and explanation of the updated billing to the City based on the recent changes related to street sweeping and our efforts to maintain full route coverage with a reduced number of drivers.

	Month	Annual Billing	Notes
7/1/2025 to 6/30/2026	\$ 68,569	\$ 822,828	Three full time drivers.
March 2026	\$ 51,250	\$ 615,000	Attempted reduce drivers for opposite side sweeping.
April 1st 2026 to June 30, 2027	\$ 62,950	\$ 944,250	Returning to three full time drivers with opposite side sweeping. Pricing is set for 15 months with no CPI increases.

As discussed during our Microsoft Teams meeting on Monday, March 30, 2026, effective Wednesday, April 1, 2026, we will be returning to three full-time drivers. After careful evaluation, it became clear that two drivers were not sufficient to consistently and fully cover the Monday through Wednesday routes.

In good faith, we have updated our pricing to help meet the City halfway by covering the opposite-side sweeping at a reduced cost until the entire city is fully reposted, specifically Thursday and Friday routes. This adjustment reflects our ongoing commitment to supporting the City while maintaining service quality and operational efficiency.

Thank you again for the continued partnership with Sweeping Corp of America. We value our relationship with the City of Fullerton and look forward to continuing to work together.
