CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:01 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Brian Yanity expressed concerns about pedestrian safety within the crosswalk at Pomona Avenue and Commonwealth Avenue. He suggested the addition of a left-hand turn signal and curb extension.

Julie Rayburn expressed concerns about pedestrian safety at the roundabout on Woods Avenue and Wilshire Avenue. She brought attention to the speeding traffic around the neighborhood and a lack of stop signs and crosswalks.

Maureen Milton asked about access to past public Transportation and Circulation Commission meetings, road construction on the weekends, walkability audits, and had questions about traffic related terms and signals.
