#### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

City Council must designate a voting delegate to vote at the Annual Business Meeting. City Council may also appoint up to two alternate voting delegates. One of the alternate delegates may vote at the Business Meeting in the event the designated voting delegate cannot attend.
