SUMMARY

ORDINANCE NO. 3338 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 7.105.020 (CAMPING UNLAWFUL) AND CHAPTER 7.36 (OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC PLACES AND PUBLIC FACILITIES) OF THE FULLERTON MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS PROHIBITING THE USE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND FACILITIES FOR STORAGE OF PERSONAL ITEMS OR AS A PLACE TO SIT, SLEEP OR LIE DOWN
