**SUBJECT:** PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT  
AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO WITH LG2WB ENGINEERS,  
INC.

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### SUMMARY

Request to approve one-year agreement extension with Linscott, Law, & Greenspan, Engineers (LLG), a dba entity of LG2WB Engineers, Inc. for continued on-call traffic engineering services.

### PROPOSED MOTION

1. Approve Amendment Number Two to the Professional Services Agreement with LG2WB Engineers, Inc. for a one-year extension to continue on-call professional traffic engineering consulting services not-to-exceed \$120,000.
2. Authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute Amendment Number Two, in a form approved by the City Attorney.
3. Authorize Administrative Services Director, or designee, to issue \$120,000 purchase order to LG2WB Engineers, Inc. to continue professional traffic engineering consulting services.

### PRIORITY POLICY STATEMENT

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The FY 2026-27 Public Works General Engineering Traffic Division operational budget and applicable Capital Improvement Program projects within Capital Projects Fund (Fund 74) would support this extension. The consultant would maintain the current rate schedule not-to-exceed \$120,000 through June 30, 2027. Staff does not request budget appropriations.

#### DISCUSSION

The original contract term with LLG ran July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023 and included three optional one-year extensions. The City executed an amendment to the original agreement on December 23, 2021 to include additional services related to increased private development and staff augmentation needs. The final extension provides LLG consultant services through June 30, 2026.

LLG provided on-call traffic engineering services for many years and as well as private development project review, Capital Improvement Program project design and traffic signal system maintenance and operations. LLG conducts all work under the City Traffic Engineer direction and only with prior authorization.

LLG is assisting with two traffic signal designs, traffic signal synchronization project implementation and staff augmentation for traffic signal operation maintenance, programming, timing and inspection. The City would benefit by continuing work with LLG for traffic signal design completion and synchronization operational programming.

Staff recommends extending the LLG contract for an additional year based on current projects status, previous years' performance, experience, historical knowledge and ongoing role with traffic engineering-related tasks. Staff would issue a Request for Proposals in FY 2026-27, to establish a new contract for consultant traffic engineering services.
