Prior to public comments, the public may request the removal of consent items for further discussion. Those wishing to speak on a regular business or a public hearing item on this agenda may do so when the Chair calls that specific item for consideration.

Each speaker addressing the Commission may have three minutes to make their remarks. No person shall speak more than one time about the same item. The Chair may request that a spokesperson represent a group wishing to address the Commission. The Chair or majority of the Transportation and Circulation Commission may grant an extension of time for a speaker. No speaker may yield their time to another speaker.

PERSONS ADDRESSING THE COMMISSION: See special notice regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19) and Transportation and Circulation Commission meeting participation for instructions to participate in the meeting. State your name and city of residence for the record at the beginning of your remarks. All speakers shall observe civility, decorum, and good behavior. Any item submitted to the Commission during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.

2. EARLY MORNING PARKING RESTRICTION REPEAL – NORTH SIDE EVERGREEN AVENUE BETWEEN PONDEROSA AVENUE AND 250-FEET EAST OF BREA BOULEVARD
