



Staff will forward correspondence received to the legislative body. Correspondence is not read at the meeting, however, all correspondence becomes part of the official record of the meeting. Telephone Users: Press star-nine (*9) on your phone to raise your hand. Press star-six (*6) to unmute when it is your turn to address City Council.

Lower your hand if you chose not to speak or after you have made your comments by unchecking the raise hand option online.

- 2. Staff will call your name or the last four digits of your phone number when it is your time to speak.
- 3. Please state your name and city of residence at the beginning of your remarks for the minutes.
- 4. Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.
- 5. You may log off or hang up after making your comments.
