The public may comment on matters not appearing on the agenda and Consent Calendar items during Public Comments at the Regular Session meeting. Prior to public comments, the public may request the removal of consent items for further discussion. Those wishing to speak on a regular business or a public hearing item on this agenda may do so when the Mayor / Chair calls that specific item for consideration.

Each speaker addressing non-agenda and consent calendar items shall have three minutes to make their remarks. City Council / Agency / Authority will allow no more than a total of 30 minutes at the beginning of the Regular Session for non-agenda comments. Those speaking on regular business items and public hearing items shall have no more than three minutes per item to address City Council / Agency / Authority. No person shall speak more than one time to the same item. The Mayor / Chair may request that a spokesperson represent a group wishing to address City Council / Agency / Authority. The Mayor / Chair or majority of the Council / Agency / Authority may grant an extension of time for a speaker. No speaker may yield their time to another speaker.

**PERSONS ADDRESSING CITY COUNCIL:** Please complete a speaker form and submit the form to the Assistant City Clerk in the lobby prior to approaching the podium. State your name and city of residence for the record at the beginning of your remarks. All speakers shall observe civility, decorum and good behavior. Any item submitted to the City Council / Agency / Authority during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.
