You can find the raise hand option under your participant name on your computer or smart device or press "*9" (star-nine) on your phone to raise your hand. Press star-six (*6) to unmute.

You can lower your hand if you chose not to speak or after you have made your comments by unchecking the raise hand option online.

- 3. Staff will notify you when it is your turn to speak.
- 4. Please state your name and city of residence at the beginning of your remarks for the minutes.
- 5. Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.
- 6. You may log off or hang up after making your comments.
