- 5. Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.

INFRASTRUCTURE CONDITIONS AND FUNDING REPORT REVIEW

Summary: Review of Infrastructure Conditions and Funding Report, prepared in February 2020. This report was a collaboration between INRAC and City staff to summarize City infrastructure conditions and maintenance needs, in addition to providing recommended annual funding needs and potential methods to fund the annual needs.

Recommended Action: Ratify report recommendations.

2. WATER BILL DISPUTE REVIEW

Summary: Proposed revisions to Rule 10 of the Water Rates, Rules and Regulations could potentially affect decisions made by INRAC's Water Bill Dispute Panel. There are two disputes previously heard by the Water Bill Dispute Panel that have since been elevated for review by City Council. Based on the proposed Rule 10 revisions, the Panel could reconsider the decisions of these two disputes.

Recommended Action: Provide direction.
