On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 (superseding the Brown Actrelated provisions of Executive Order N-25-20 issued on March 12, 2020), which allows a local legislative body to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to observe and to address the local legislative body. Pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20, some or all of the Fullerton City Council may participate in meetings via teleconference.

1. Use the "raise hand" function to join the queue to speak on the current agenda item when the Mayor calls the item for discussion.

Computer / Smart Device Users: You can find the raise hand option under your participant name.

Telephone Users: Press star-nine (*9) on your phone to raise your hand. Press star-six (*6) to unmute when it is your turn to address City Council.

Lower your hand if you chose not to speak or after you have made your comments by unchecking the raise hand option online.

- 2. Staff will call your name or the last four digits of your phone number when it is your time to speak.
- **3.** Please state your name and city of residence at the beginning of your remarks.
- 4. Speakers will have up to three minutes to make their remarks.
- 5. You may log off or hang up after making your comments.

DISCLAIMER: Participant names and/or phone numbers will be visible to all participants. The City records all public meetings.

NOTE: The Council Meeting video will not stream through the Zoom meeting. To view the meeting, please go to https://fullerton.legistar.com, Spectrum Cable Channel 3 or AT&T U-Verse Channel 99. However, please listen to the audio of the meeting though Zoom as you wait for your turn to speak. The video stream has up to a 30 second delay and you may miss your turn to speak if you are not listening through the Zoom app.

SPECIAL MEETINGS: The Mayor or a majority of the legislative body may call a special meeting of the City Council with a minimum 24 hours' notice.

PUBLIC COMMENT: City Council may limit public comments to only items on the special meeting agenda. Each speaker addressing City Council shall have three minutes to make their remarks. No person shall speak more than one time to the same item. The Mayor may request that a spokesperson represent a group wishing to address City Council. The Mayor or majority of the Council may grant an extension of time for a speaker. No speaker may yield their time to another speaker.

PERSONS ADDRESSING CITY COUNCIL: See special notice regarding COVID-19 and City Council meeting participation for instructions to participate in the meeting. State your name and city of residence for the record at the beginning of your remarks. All speakers shall observe civility, decorum and good behavior. Any item submitted to City Council during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.

AGENDA ITEMS: This agenda contains a summary of each item the Council / Agency will consider. The City Clerk's Office posts the special meeting agenda no later than 24 hours prior to the special meeting at www.cityoffullerton.com.

In accordance with CA Government Code Section 54957.5, the public may inspect any writings or documents relating to an open session agenda item distributed after posting of the agenda packet but prior to the meeting. The City will post such writings and documents received in sufficient time on the City's website at www.cityoffullerton.com.

State regulations prohibit City Council from acting on non-agenda items except as provided by law. Visit www.cityoffullerton.com, email cityclerksoffice@cityoffullerton.com or call (714) 738-6350 for more information.
