


Local History Moment



Rapid postwar housing growth, coupled with a booming economy, led to a fast-paced expansion in Fullerton education. Set on 42 acres in West Fullerton, the city's second high school, Sunny Hills, was designed by William H. Harrison, renowned educational architect. When classes opened to new freshman and sophomore students in September 1959, under the leadership of Principal Oswald Egertson, many school buildings were still under construction, and the students had to carry all of their textbooks until lockers were installed several weeks later.



Just four years before Sunny Hills High School opened in Fullerton, Marty McFly, under the guidance of Doc Brown, was able to find his way from 1955 Hill Valley High School and return back to the future.




