SUBJECT: E-RATE FUNDING OF TECHNOLOGY NEEDS RECONSIDERED

SUMMARY

Staff presented and the board approved an E-Rate funding of technology needs for the library at their meeting of February 25, 2021. The staff memo of the item is attached. Staff continues to seek more information to see if this project should go forward.

RECOMMENDATION

Rescind approval of this project and direct staff to explore other uses of the grant funds that are available to the library during the current grant period ending on September 30, 2026.

FISCAL IMPACT

As staff have begun work on this project, they find that clarification on the scope of work is needed. Staff is working with the grant consultant (Ed Technology) and City IT (Glass Box) to be satisfied that this project should go forward and will seek confirmation
