FISCAL IMPACT

DISCUSSION

\$3.8 Million in Unfunded City Positions – the Library Portion

City Departments had to contribute unfilled positions to cut the City's deficit. The Library Director chose two positions which had been left unfilled for many years:

Circulation Division – Library Technical Assistant – 1.0 FTE* \$71,441

Circulation Division – Library Clerical Assistant - .5 FTE* \$32,626 \$104,067

2.5% City Wide Budget Cut – the Library Portion

City Departments had to hold vacant positions in order to reduce their budgets by 2.5%. The Library Director chose two positions and non-regular staffing hours that would hopefully have the least impact on library operations:

Administration Division Administrative Assistant – 1.0 FTE*	\$72,246
Technical Services Division – Library Tech'l Asst. I 1.0 FTE*	\$73,186
All Library Divisions – non-regular hours	\$39,313 \$184.745
