SUMMARY

The Downtown Active Transportation Plan (Plan) is a long-range plan to guide future improvements related to Active Transportation within and/or leading to the Downtown. The City received grant funding from California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) and Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) to specifically study this project area and identify opportunities for connection improvements to enhance and encourage active transportation.

FISCAL IMPACT

The adoption of the resolution has no fiscal impact. The adoption of the Plan will assist the City in remaining competitive for future grant opportunities.

DISCUSSION

The Plan provides a set of implementable actions to guide future improvements and serves as a foundation for a safer, more connected and accessible community. The Plan integrates walking, bicycling and other transportation modes into a single plan that includes infrastructure recommendations as well as identifying specific funding sources and implementation strategies. The Plan builds on previous planning efforts in the City, such as the Fullerton General Plan, the Bicycle Master Plan, the Pedestrian Safety Assessment and related work completed on the Draft Fullerton Transportation Center Specific Plan. In coordination with these prior efforts, the new projects and programs identified in this Plan will work to address mobility needs in Downtown Fullerton.

The Plan includes Vision and Goals, Existing Conditions, Community Engagement, Bicycle and Pedestrian Programs, Network Recommendations, Project Prioritization and Implementation. Adoption of this Plan will assist the City in remaining competitive to secure available state and regional grants.

The City focused on community engagement as part of the preparation of the Plan. The engagement included:

- stakeholder meetings
- a project webpage
- online input map
- public survey
- social media posts and ads
- community workshops and pop-ups
- community surveys
- mapping
- attendance at events.

In addition, the City's Active Transportation Committee (ATC) reviewed the plan several times. The ATC recommended adoption of the Plan at its April 20, 2022 meeting.
