# FY 22-23 CIP Budget Street Funds

The following street funding allocations are approved for the FY 2022-23 CIP Budget:



Infrastructure Fund	\$500,000	Allocated to Brookhurst Rd
Grant – Federal	\$409,000	Allocated to Associated Rd (Yorba Linda to Bastanchury)
Grant – CDBG	\$390,395 <sup>(2)</sup>	Allocated to Brookdale Pl.
Other – City Contribution	\$300,000	Joint project with Anaheim. Anaheim will contribute to the project.




# ARPA – Revenue Replacement Funds

- In February 2022, City Council appropriated \$13.1 million of ARPA revenue replacement funds to street repair and rehabilitation.
- Staff allocated these funds as follows:
  - FY 21-22 = \$2.1 million FY 22-23 = \$5.5 million FY 23-24 = \$5.5 million
  - Appropriated \$1.7 million in FY 21-22 to two projects
- City has carryover funds available from FY 21-22 to address additional street projects.
  - Carryover of approximately \$390,000 of remaining ARPA funds
  - Use of ARPA funds in FY 21-22 has allowed carryover of approximately \$2.5-2.75 million of M2 and Gas Tax from the FY 21-22 budget.
