SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF TOBACCO GRANT AMENDMENT

SUMMARY

City Council approval is requested for an addendum to increase funding for a current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the California Department of Justice to reduce the accessibility and use of tobacco products to children and underage youth in the City of Fullerton.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Chief of Police to:

- 1.) Sign the addendum to the Tobacco Grant MOU for the additional grant amount of \$87,123 and increase Police Department appropriations to Grant Fund 32 in the same amount, thereby increasing the total award to \$302,054.
- 2.) Sign future amendments, increases in funds, and extensions for this grant.

PRIORITY POLICY STATEMENT

FISCAL IMPACT

Grant funds will reimburse for officer overtime and operational supplies related to the grant.

DISCUSSION

The City Council approved a California Department of Justice Tobacco Grant MOU on June 5, 2018 to reduce the accessibility and use of tobacco products to children and underage youth in the City of Fullerton. The MOU was in the amount of \$214,931, became effective upon signature and will expire June 30, 2020.

The Department of Justice has awarded the Fullerton Police Department additional funds through this grant in the amount of \$87,123, pending approval by the City Council of the attached addendum, for a total grant amount of \$302,054.
