SUBJECT:	RENEWAL OF ONE-YEAR AFTER SCHOOL EDUCATION AND SAFETY GRANT – PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

SUMMARY

This one-year After School Education and Safety (ASES) Grant agreement will provide funding for the Parks and Recreation Staff to support after school program activities at Topaz Elementary School in the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District. The Parks and Recreation Department will receive funding in the amount of \$38,836.50 - the same amount received between Fiscal Years 2015 and 2018.

RECOMMENDATION

City Council approve the 2018-19 Independent Contractor Agreement between Placentia-Yorba Linda School District and City of Fullerton and authorize the Parks and Recreation Director to sign this agreement and subsequent amendments.

FISCAL IMPACT

The agreement will provide grant funding in the amount of \$38,836.50.

DISCUSSION

The Parks and Recreation Department provides after school programs as a contractor to the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District. These services are provided to students attending Topaz Elementary School. Although Topaz Elementary School is located in the City of Placentia, the student body is made up of primarily Fullerton residents.

The program includes homework assistance and after school enrichment activities for 80 students.

Funding is provided through the ASES program. Reimbursement to the City from the District is provided based on three support staff used to supplement the district-run program.
