SUBJECT:	RENEWAL OF ONE-YEAR AFTER SCHOOL EDUCATION AND SAFETY GRANT – FULLERTON SCHOOL DISTRICT

### SUMMARY

This one-year After School Education & Safety (ASES) Grant agreement will provide funding for the Parks and Recreation staff to support after school program activities at Maple Elementary School and Orangethorpe Elementary School in the Fullerton School District. The Parks & Recreation Department will receive funding in the amount of \$304,137, the same amount received in fiscal year 2017-18.

#### RECOMMENDATION

City Council approve the 2018-19 Independent Contractor Agreement between Fullerton School District and City of Fullerton and authorize the Parks and Recreation Director to sign this agreement and subsequent amendments.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The agreement will provide grant funding in the amount of \$304,137.

#### DISCUSSION

The Parks and Recreation Department provides after school programs as a contractor to the Fullerton School District. These services are provided to students attending Maple Elementary School and Orangethorpe Elementary School. The program includes homework assistance and after school enrichment activities for 151 students at Orangethorpe and 84 students at Maple.

Funding is provided through the ASES program. Reimbursement to the City from the District is provided based on student attendance from the city-run program.
