SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF A COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD
MEMBER FOR BRIDGES AT KRAEMER PLACE COUNTY
HOMELESS SHELTER

SUMMARY

The County of Orange requests that City Council designate a voting representative to sit on the Community Advisory Board (CAB).

The CAB is a contractual requirement of the shelter operator to ensure a forum for community feedback.

RECOMMENDATION

Designate a voting representative (City Council Member) to sit on the Community Advisory Board for the Bridges at Kraemer Place County Homeless Shelter.

PRIORITY POLICY STATEMENT

FISCAL IMPACT

There will be no fiscal impact for the designation of a voting representative to the CAB.

DISCUSSION

The CAB is an advisory body to the operator of Bridges at Kraemer Place, having no independent authority to act on matters such as legislation or lobbying and whose primary functions are to:

- Provide review of shelter operations, enhance community relations, and to promote open communication between community stakeholders concerning the operation of the program.
- Receive and address information and concerns from the neighborhood, local businesses, city and county entities, service provider partners and shelter clients and communicate that information to the County.

The representatives serve at the will of the entity that appoints them until or unless they are replaced by the appointing entity.

The bylaws do not provide for alternates or delegates to sit or vote on behalf of the appointed members
