SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF 2018-19 OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY AGREEMENT

SUMMARY

City Council is being asked to authorize and accept a continuing grant of \$446,116 for traffic enforcement, DUI operations and DUI-related training of officers from the State of California Office of Traffic Safety.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Acting Chief of Police to execute the 2018-19 Office of Traffic Safety "Selective Traffic Enforcement Program" (STEP) agreement in the amount of \$446,116.00 in a form approved by the City Attorney as well as any amendments, and increase Police Department appropriations by the same amount in Grants Fund 32.

PRIORITY POLICY STATEMENT

This item matches the following Priority Policy Statement:

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated revenue and expenses are \$446,116. This grant also helps fund traffic safety services that might otherwise be paid for through general funds.

DISCUSSION

The California Office of Traffic Safety has awarded the Fullerton Police Department a continuing "Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)" grant, funded for \$446,116.00. The 2018-19 STEP grant is designed to reduce the number of deaths and injuries involving alcohol, speed, red light running and other primary collision factors. The City Council must approve the grant in order for the City to receive this funding.
