### **SUMMARY**

The County of Orange Office on Aging provides the City with funding through the Older Americans Act Title III-B grant program for senior programs. The initial award for Fiscal Year 2018-19 is \$87,744.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Authorize the Director of Parks and Recreation to sign the grant agreement and amendments for the Older Americans Act Titles III-B grant program with the County of Orange Office on Aging for Fiscal Year 2018-19.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The City will receive an initial award of \$87,744 in County funds. The City is required to provide \$10,327 in matching funds. Both the initial award and the City matching funds, are included in the approved Fiscal Year 2018-19 budget.

## DISCUSSION

The City has received Older Americans Act Title III-B funding for the purpose of providing recreation, wellness and social service programs to the City's older adults since the 1970's. These programs, classes and services provide older adults the opportunity to engage in organized enriching activities that promote health, vitality and well-being. The grant funds will serve about 4,500 seniors with programs, material aid (government surplus commodities and Senior Grocery Program) and outreach.
