

ORDINANCE NO. XXXX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 8.48.040 OF THE FULLERTON MUNICIPAL
CODE PERTAINING TO CITATION AUTHORITY

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Amend Section 8.48.040 of the Fullerton Municipal Code as follows:

All police officers, ~~and~~ parking control officers **and parking control aides** of the City **and others as designated by the Chief of Police** shall be and are authorized to give citations to any and all persons violating any of the provisions of this chapter. Violations of this chapter are civil parking penalties owed to the City subject to the provisions of Chapter 17 of the California Vehicle Code.

SECTION 2. Any provision of the Fullerton Municipal Code or appendices thereto inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies and not further, is hereby repealed or modified to that extent necessary to effect the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, phrase or clause of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, phrase or clause thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, phrases, or clauses may be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published in the manner required by law. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty days from and after its passage.
