SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO CITYWIDE REGULATIONS FOR BUSINESSES SELLING ALCOHOL AND OFFERING ENTERTAINMENT – SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE

SUMMARY

City Council introduced the first reading of an ordinance to amend the Fullerton Municipal Code pertaining to citywide regulations for businesses selling alcohol and offering entertainment as amended at the April 16, 2019 City Council meeting.

ORDINANCE NO. 3270 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING TITLES 15 AND 3 OF THE FULLERTON MUNICIPAL CODE TO UPDATE DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONAL STANDARDS, PROCESSES AND ENFORCEMENT TOOLS FOR BUSINESSES SELLING ALCOHOL FOR ON-SITE CONSUMPTION AND FOR BUSINESSES WITH ENTERTAINMENT
