The City Treasurer is a key position in the City, responsible for the receipt and disbursement of all City funds, the management of the City's \$115 million investment

portfolio and the reporting of investment activity to the City Council. This position is currently held by the Director of Administrative Services, Michael B. O'Kelly, who is resigning at the end of the month.

Fullerton Municipal Code Section 2.07.010 requires that the appointment to this position be made directly by the City Council. It is recommended that Kenneth A. Domer, City Manager, be appointed as the Acting City Treasurer effective June 1, 2019.
