SUBJECT: 136 W. ELM AVENUE - DISABLED PERSONS PARKING

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### SUMMARY

Consider a request from the property owner at 136 w. Elm Avenue for a disabled person's parking space in front of their home.

### RECOMMENDATION

Approve the request for a Disabled Persons Parking space in front of 136 W. Elm Avenue, as shown in Exhibit "A" (Attachment No.1).

### DISCUSSION

Elm Avenue is a 34-foot wide, east/west residential street with a prima facie speed limit of 25 miles per hour. There is improved curb, gutter and sidewalk on both sides of the street. The street is comprised of single-family residential homes on both sides of the street. On-street parking, as well as "Early Morning Parking" between the hours of 2:00am and 5:00am is permitted on both sides of W. Elm Avenue. This particular residence was built in 1936 and has a 1-car garage off of the alley at the rear of the property. Parking in the alley is permitted.

The request for a Disabled Persons Parking space was made in an effort to secure close proximity parking near the front of their home for a resident with very limited mobility. On-street parking is limited on the street, resulting in the property owner having to park a distance from the home which isn't physically an option.

The property is ADA compliant for ambulatory needs as is required of the request.
