WHEREAS, CITY agrees to construct Transportation Control Measures projects as noted in the 2021 FTIP and 2021 FTIP amendments in a timely manner.

WHEREAS, CITY will submit the Citywide Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement, Fullerton Transportation Center Elevators Expansion and Wilshire Avenue Bicycle Boulevard projects to the 2021 FTIP and certify these projects are fully funded.

WHEREAS, Orange County Transportation Agency will handle FTIP process for the State College Grade Separation and Raymond Grade Separation through separate action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fullerton does hereby affirm the City's commitment to the projects submitted in the 2021 Federal Transportation Improvement Program.
