

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE CALRECYCLE RUBBERIZED PAVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM AND TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle") to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's ("State") efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment.

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grant.

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

WHEREAS, the CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant Program provides funding for local agencies that use Rubberized Asphalt Concrete products derived from California-generated waste tires as part of pavement maintenance treatments.

WHEREAS, the City of Fullerton has begun using rubberized asphalt concrete to resurface streets, and seeks to utilize the CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant funding to supplement local capital funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON DOES HEREBY FIND AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Public Works Director or designee is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant Program Funding.
2. The Public Works Director or designee is authorized to negotiate and execute any documents necessary to effectuate the grant funding.
3. These authorizations are effective for five years from the date of adoption of this resolution.
