
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING 57 FEET OF CURB ON THE EAST SIDE OF EUCLID STREET, DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 2226 NORTH EUCLID STREET, AS A PLACE WHERE VEHICLES ARE PROHIBITED FROM STOPPING ANYTIME

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That 57 feet of curb on the east side of Euclid Street, directly in front of 2226 North Euclid Street, in the City of Fullerton as shown in Exhibit "A", is hereby designated as a place where vehicles are prohibited from stopping anytime.
- 2. That the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to install red curb designating said location as prohibited parking.
