Reasons to Update Policy

Strengthen Priority for Recreational Play

Define Partnership Status

- Better define requirements to become and remain a Partner
- Address Youth Sports Changes
 - Increases in travel / club sports
 - Increase in development academies
 - Increase in rental demand

Highlights of Updated Policy

Focus on Recreational Play

- Create definitions to distinguish between recreational play and competitive play
- Create a roadmap for Partners to better operate their volunteer recreational sports organizations
- Clarify the application and allocation process
- Create field rule compliance process

Address Increased Demand from Travel/Club Sports

- Created a Fullerton Competitive category with two tiers
- Reduced field reservation limits for rental groups

Policy Review Timeline

March - Policy reviewed by Partners

April - An updated draft policy was posted online for public review

April to June - City staff met with Partner groups, Commissioners and public to gather feedback

June - Policy was reviewed at Parks and Recreation Commission meeting

July to August - City staff met with Partner groups, Commissioners and public to gather feedback

September - Parks and Recreation Commission recommended approval of policy

Staff has met with several cities including Brea, Costa Mesa, Newport Beach and Placentia to discuss and compare sports policy issues.
