






Union Pacific Park & Vicinity




Union Pacific Park (1.7 acres)



Union Pacific Park

- 1.7 acres
- Located near the downtown area, west of the Transportation Center
- Established in 2003 (purchased from Union Pacific Railroad in 1998)
- Closed for 10 years
 - Soil Remediation (DTSC) / Litigation between parties
 - Illicit Activity
 - Redevelopment Dissolution / State Department of Finance
 - Funding/Budget Issues








Renewable Farms

- Established in 2008
- Mission enhance communities through events, agriculture and education
- Current location in Anaheim
- Grow produce through Aquaponics
- Outdoor event rentals







Proposed use for Union Pacific Park

- Urban Farm similar to Renewable Farms
 - Recreation / open space for passive uses
 - Education
 - Internships
 - Public and private events
 - Retail local residents / walking distance
 - Public Art
 - Festivals















Recommendation:

Authorize the City Manager to enter into an ENA with Renewable Farms.

Staff will return to City Council for approval of a formal agreement and to present a concept for the park's proposed use.
